# Aims & Objectives

## Overall Aim:

- To contribute to the overall PESSCL PSA target by improving the quality & quantity of inter school competition for Young People aged between 5-16.

## Objectives:

- To increase the number of Young People in KS1-4 competing in inter school competition in line with national PESSCL targets.
- To increase the range of sports available through a competitive experience.
- To increase the quality of competitions as demonstrated by the Young People taking part.

# Role

## How?

- By working using the National Competition Framework for Young People in order to support existing provision and develop new opportunities for young people to take part in competitive sport, ensuring that such opportunities remain accessible to all and are effectively linked to other strands of PESSCL and individual sports wider structures.

compliment upper KS2 structure and  
which target different children.

County Structure in 8 sports  
Local – District – County  
(Cluster – Partnership – Inter  
Partnership)

Central venue leagues offering regular  
participation in selected sports – local  
call depending on sport infrastructure.

SSP driven participation events e.g.  
orienteering to target young people &  
schools not engaged

Central Venue SSP competitions in  
range of sports.  
District Competitions offered by NGBs,  
SSAs.

County 'Core' sports and locally  
identified sports.  
SSP & District competitions.  
PESSCL data driven Year Group events.
