Safeguarding & Protecting Children

Course Information

- Identify the foundations of safeguarding, good practice and child protection
- Describe the different categories of child abuse and recognise the signs and symptoms of each
- Provide you with knowledge of how to take appropriate action if concerns are raised

Further Information: This workshop focuses on good practice to protect the child and the coach in a sporting environment. This is a prerequisite for many NGB coaching qualifications and a criteria for Clubmark accreditation, and upon completion you will receive a nationally recognised certificate.

Candidates for this workshop who are aged 16-18 must be accompanied by either a parent, mentor or coach from the same club who is 18 and who could spend time with them to answer any specific questions. However, if the guardian accompanying the under 18 be not actively participating in the workshop, they will not be charged an attendance fee
